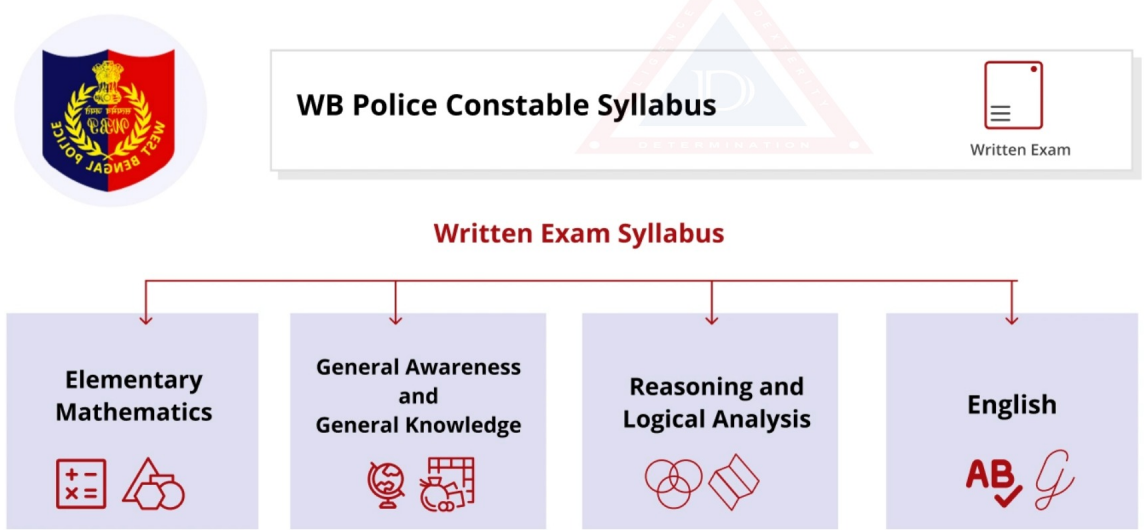

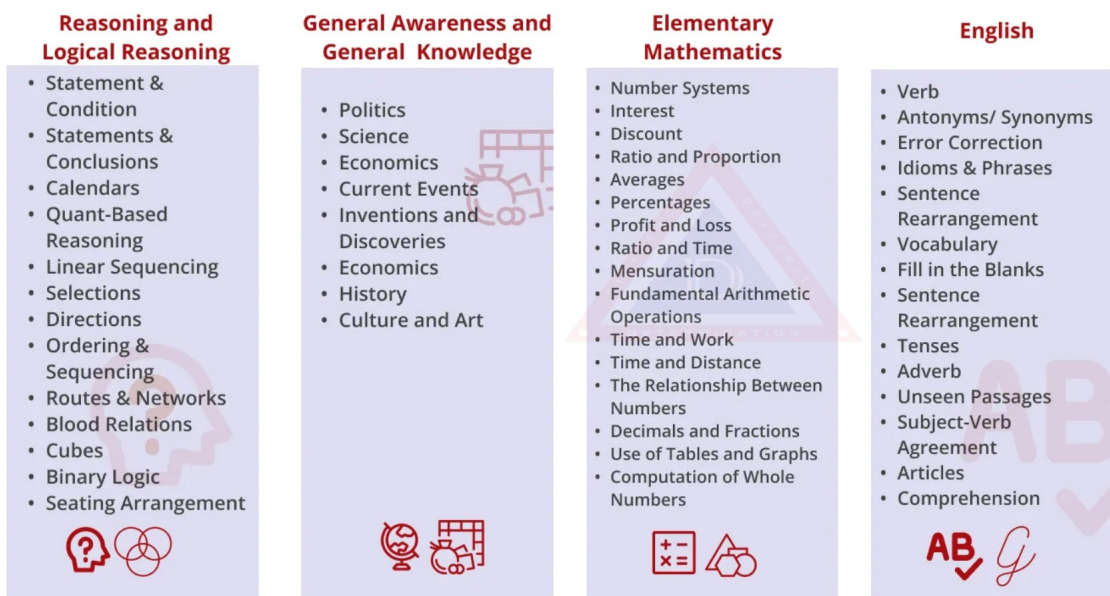
Complete WBP Constable Syllabus 2024 - Written Examination

The WB Police Constable Exam comprises four main stages:

Written Examination (85 marks):

- The written exam consists of 85 multiple-choice questions, totaling 85 marks.
- There is a penalty of 0.25 marks deducted for each incorrect answer.
- No marks are deducted for unanswered questions.
- The exam is conducted in Bengali and Nepali languages.
- You will have 1 hour to complete the exam.

Physical Measurement Test (PMT):

- Based on your Written Examination score, you will qualify for the Physical Measurement Test (PMT), which is qualifying in nature.
- PMT assesses physical standards such as height and weight using electronic machines. Male candidates undergo chest measurements with a measuring tape.
- Qualifying in PMT allows participation in PET.

Physical Efficiency Test (PET):

- Candidates who qualify in PMT proceed to PET.



Interview (15 marks):

- Candidates who qualify in PET are invited for an Interview.
- The West Bengal Police Recruitment Board determines the procedure, date, time, and venue for the Interview.
- The Interview evaluates general awareness, suitability for public service, and proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing Bengali/Nepali languages.
