**Physical Efficiency Test (PET)**

In the Physical Efficiency Test, your performance will be evaluated based on various criteria such as the 400-meter run or 800-meter run. The specific details can be found in the excerpt below from the official notification:

**F. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) :-**

Sl. No.	Class of Candidate	Minimum Efficiency
1.	Male candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	800 metres run within 3 minutes.
2.	Female candidates (Unarmed Branch)	400 metres run within 2 minutes.
3.	Transgender Candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	400 metres run within 1 minute 40 seconds.

**Final Combined Competitive Examination**

The Final Combined Competitive Examination will include three papers with conventional type questions:

**Paper I:** General Studies and Arithmetic, totaling 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, 25 marks for Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and 25 marks for Arithmetic), with a duration of 2 hours.

**Paper II:** English, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.

**Paper III:** Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.

**Personality Test**

A select few candidates who meet all the eligibility criteria for the position will be chosen based on merit from the results of the Final Combined Competitive Examination. They will then be summoned to participate in the Personality Test. A minimum passing score of 8 marks is required for the personality test.
