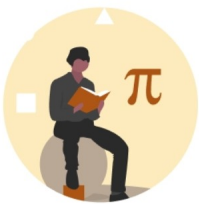

CSIR CASE Exam Pattern 2023- Paper I

CSIR CASE Exam Pattern 2023 - 150 Questions in 120 Minutes

- Paper I comprises two sections: General Awareness and English Language & Comprehension.
- In the General Awareness section, there will be 100 objective questions, each carrying one mark. For every incorrect answer, a penalty of 0.33 marks will be deducted.
- Similarly, the English Language & Comprehension section will consist of 50 Objective Type Questions, each worth one mark. An incorrect answer will result in a deduction of 0.33 marks.
- The duration of Paper I will be 120 minutes.

CSIR CASE Exam Pattern 2023- Paper II

- Paper II focuses on General Intelligence, Reasoning, and Mental Ability.
- This section will consist of 200 Objective Type Questions, each carrying a weightage of one mark. A negative marking of 0.33 marks will be applied for each incorrect response.
- Finally, paper II will span for a duration of 150 minutes.

CSIR CASE Exam Pattern 2023- Paper III

- Paper III will be of a descriptive nature.
- Moreover, this paper will feature two questions on essay writing, one question on precis writing, and one question on letter/application writing.
- Additionally, this paper will have a duration of 120 minutes.

Paper– I, Paper- II and Paper- III will be common and compulsory for all the posts.

All the papers will be bilingual (English & Hindi) except English Language Part of Paper – I which will be in English only.

Minimum threshold marks, wherever prescribed/required, will be decided by the Competent Authority.

Please note that after the completion of Papers I, II, and III, there will be an interview round carrying 100 marks specifically for the position of Section Officer (Gen/F&A/S&P). Additionally, a Computer Proficiency Test (CPT) carrying 100 marks will be conducted exclusively for the posts of Assistant Section Officer (Gen/F&A/S&P). It's important to mention that the CPT is of a qualifying nature.
