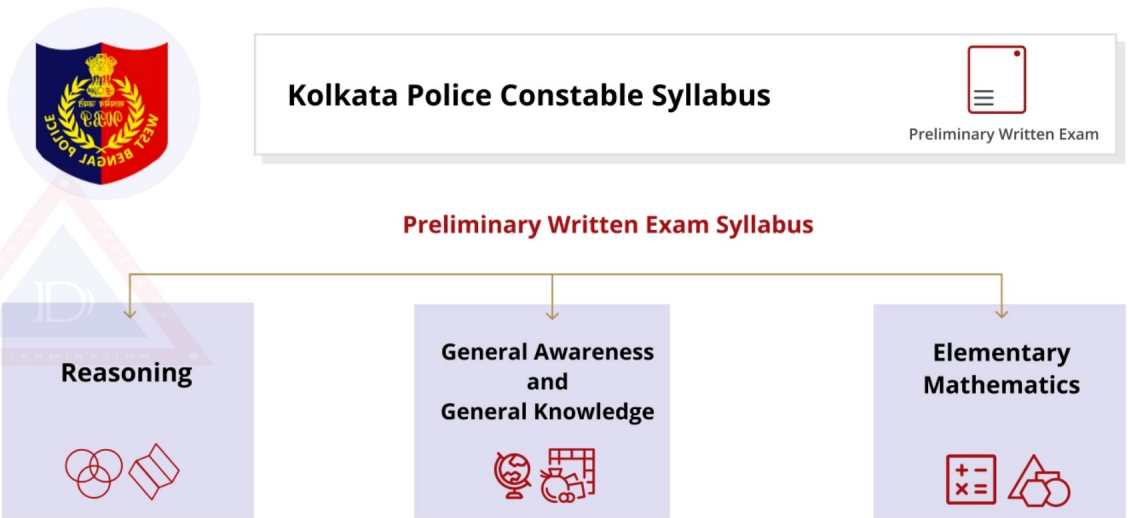

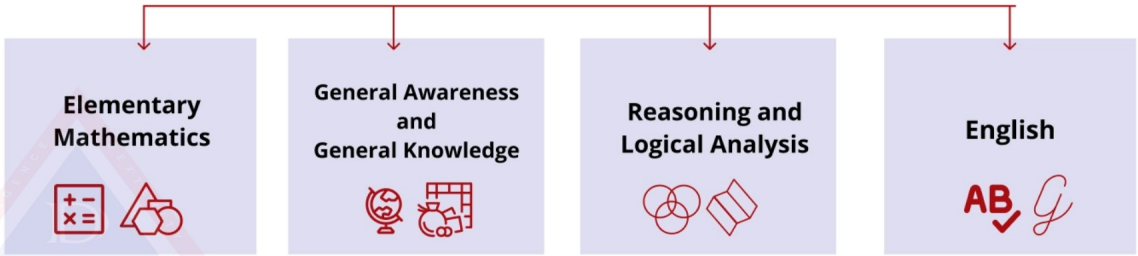

### Preliminary Written Test Exam Pattern

The Preliminary Written Test consists of 100 objective type questions with multiple-choice answers, totaling 100 marks.

The duration of this test will be one hour.

Additionally, there will be a penalty for wrong answers, with 1/4th of the allotted marks for a question deducted for each incorrect response.

The questions in the Preliminary Written Test will cover the following subjects:

- General Awareness and General Knowledge: 40 Marks
- Elementary Mathematics (Madhyamik standard): 30 Marks
- Reasoning: 30 Marks



### Final Written Exam Pattern

The Final Written Examination consists of 85 Multiple Choice Objective Type Questions (MCQs), each carrying 1 mark.

The duration of the examination is 1 hour.

There is a negative marking for each incorrect answer, with 1/4th of the allotted marks deducted for each incorrect answer.
