WB Police Constable PET

If you qualify in the PMT, you will be allowed to participate in the PET. Moreover, the PET is qualifying in nature. Furthermore, ex-servicemen must present original documents proving their service to receive relaxation in the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) on the date of their field test. Additionally, Third Gender individuals must provide an original Certificate of Identity and Identity Card issued by the competent authority during the PMT and PET to support their claim.



WB Police Constable Eligibility Criteria

Before you begin preparing for the Physical Efficiency Test (PET), it is crucial to first verify that you meet the eligibility criteria. To assist you, we have detailed all the necessary eligibility requirements below. Make sure to review each criterion carefully to ensure you qualify before proceeding with your preparation.

- · You must be a citizen of India.
- You must be at least 18 years old and no more than 30 years old as of 01/01/2024.
- · You must have passed the Madhyamik Examination from the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or its equivalent.
- You must be able to speak, read, and write the Bengali language, except if you are a permanent resident of the hill sub-divisions of Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts.
