- **Group A & C:** 21 to 36 years
- **Group B:** 20 to 36 years
- **Group D:** 21 to 39 years

If you belong to certain categories, you may be eligible for age relaxation:

- **OBC (Non-Creamy Layer):** 3 years of relaxation
- **Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (SC/ST):** 5 years of relaxation
- **Persons with Disabilities (PwD):** Up to 45 years

WBCS 2024 Notification - Recruitment for Govt Jobs

For your online payment through debit or credit card, the fee is Rs. 210 plus a service charge of 1% of the examination fee, with a minimum of Rs. 5. If you opt for Net Banking, the service charge is Rs. 5, and for payment at a bank counter (offline payment), it's Rs. 20.

However, if you are an SC/ST candidate from West Bengal or a Person with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) with a physical disability of 40% or more, you are exempt from paying any fee. Moreover, OBC candidates from West Bengal, on the other hand, are required to pay the usual fee as mentioned above. Additionally, it's important to remember that SC/ST/OBC candidates from other states are not eligible for fee exemptions, and no fee refunds or reserves will be entertained for any other examination.
