The examination will be conducted in two parts:

1. **Part-I:** Objective Type – A multiple-choice test assessing you on key subjects.
2. **Part-II:** Conventional Type (Written Test) – A descriptive paper to evaluate writing skills and comprehension.

Furthermore, your basic knowledge of computer operation and typing skills will be assessed only after you qualify in Part I and Part II of the examination.



WBPSK Clerkship Selection Process 2025 - Part I

The Commission will conduct the Part-I examination first. Only a limited number of candidates who qualify in Part I will be eligible for Part II, which will be scheduled later.

- Part I of the WBPSK Clerkship Exam 2025 consists of three subjects: English, General Studies, and Arithmetic, with a total of 100 questions.
- The mark distribution is as follows: English carries 30 marks, General Studies is allotted 40 marks, and Arithmetic accounts for 30 marks, making a total of 100 marks.
- The examination is conducted in a multiple-choice objective format and has a duration of 90 minutes.
- Additionally, there is a negative marking system, where 0.25 marks are deducted for each incorrect response.

- Typing proficiency is required, with a minimum speed of 20 words per minute in English or 10 words per minute in Bengali.

Your final merit list ranking will be based on the combined scores of Part I and Part II, provided you meet the required standards for computer operation and typing skills. WBPSA Clerkship Eligibility Criteria
