### WBCS Main 2023 - Exam Pattern

- The WBCS Main Exam includes 8 papers: 6 compulsory and 1 optional, split into 2 papers.
- You need to pass all 6 compulsory papers and the optional subject to be eligible for selection.
- Each paper, including the optional one, is worth 200 marks.
- You'll have 3 hours to complete each paper.
- Negative marking applies to incorrect MCQs, though the exact penalty hasn't been specified by the WBPSA.

## WBPSA Miscellaneous Services - Mains Exam Pattern

- Paper 1: English, with a duration of 1 hour and 30 minutes and a maximum of 150 marks.
- Paper-2: Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali/Santali, also valued at 150 marks.
- Paper 3: General Studies and Arithmetic, totaling 150 marks (100 for General Studies and 50 for Arithmetic), with a time allocation of 2 hours and 30 minutes.

To qualify for Clerk positions, you must go through three stages of the recruitment process: Part I (objective type), Part II (conventional type—written), and a typing test.
