WBPSI Food SI will be structured in two phases - a Written Examination and a Personality Test. The written examination will encompass two subjects, each carrying 50 marks (100 marks in total), while the Personality Test is worth 20 marks.

Furthermore, the written exam has a duration of 1.5 hours

Moreover, the format involves multiple-choice objective-type questions.

WBPSI Food SI Marking Scheme

As mentioned previously, the Written Examination comprises a total of 100 marks - 50 marks for General Studies and 50 marks for Arithmetic. The duration of the written examination is set at 1.5 hours. Additionally, the Personality Test carries a weightage of 20 marks.
