The WBPSM Miscellaneous 2024 selection process comprises three consecutive stages: Preliminary Examination, which features an Objective Test; those who perform well move on to the next part, and the Final Examination, which involves a Conventional Type-Written test. Both Preliminary and Final Examinations are mandatory. The last stage is the Personality Test. Now that you've got an overview of the WBPSM Miscellaneous 2024 selection process, are you ready to dive into the details of each stage together?

WBPSM Miscellaneous 2024 Selection Process- Preliminary Examination



It's essential to note that the Preliminary Examination is a qualifying round, and the marks obtained in it won't be considered for the final merit list.

- The WBPSM Miscellaneous 2024 Preliminary Examination is a crucial screening test, comprising a single paper with 100 multiple-choice objective questions.
- These questions cover General Studies (150 marks) and Arithmetic (50 marks), with each question carrying 2 marks.
- The total duration of the exam is 1 hour and 30 minutes.

Now that you are aware of the first stage of the WBPSM Miscellaneous 2024 selection process, let us proceed to the subsequent stage and explore the Final Examination round.

WBPSM Miscellaneous 2024 Selection Process- Final Examination

The WBPSM Miscellaneous 2024 Final Examination consists of three papers with conventional-type questions.

- Paper I focuses on English, Paper II on Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali/Santali, and Paper III covers General Studies and Arithmetic.
- Each of Papers I & II carries 150 marks with a duration of 1 hour and 30 minutes. However, Paper III, totalling 150 marks, comprises 100 marks for General Studies (Group A) and 50 marks for Arithmetic (Group B), with a total time of 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Answers for Group A (General Studies) can be in English or Bengali, or Nepali, while answers for Group B (Arithmetic) must be in English or Bengali. Moreover, it is important to note that all answers for an individual group must be in the same language.

It's important to highlight that all three papers (Paper I, II & III) will be conducted on the same day.

- Your position on the Final Merit List will be determined by the total marks from all three papers of the Final Examination and your performance in the Personality Test.

This thorough evaluation guarantees a comprehensive approach in deciding the final selection for the Miscellaneous Services.



WBPSC Miscellaneous 2024 Eligibility Criteria

Before you start gearing up for the WBPSC Miscellaneous 2024 selection process, your initial and most crucial step involves assessing whether you meet the eligibility criteria. Let's simplify this for you:

- **Nationality:**
 - You need to be an Indian citizen, either by birth or through registration.
 - You are also eligible if the Government of India has declared you as such, even if you are not a natural-born Indian citizen.
- **Educational Qualifications:**
 - You should possess a degree from a recognized university or its equivalent.
 - It's essential for you to have the ability to read, write, and speak in Bengali, unless your mother tongue is Nepali, as per the Finance Department's Notification No. 1243-F(P) dated March 2, 2016.
 - If your mother tongue is different from Bengali or Nepali, your knowledge of Bengali will be assessed during the personality test.
- **Age Limit:**
 - Your age should not be less than 20 years and should not exceed 39 years as of January 1, 2023 (meaning you must have been born between January 2, 1984, and January 1, 2003).
 - - Your age, as mentioned in your Madhyamik or equivalent certificate, will be considered for this application. This rule applies to you whether you are in government service or not.
 - Age relaxations are applicable for SC/ST (up to 5 years), OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates in West Bengal (up to 3 years), and persons with benchmark disabilities.
 - It's important to note that no age relaxation applies to SC/ST/OBC candidates from other states, as they will be treated as general candidates.
