The examination will be conducted in three sequential stages:

1. Preliminary Examination (Objective Type)
2. Final Examination (Conventional Type – Written)
3. Personality Test

WBPSM Miscellaneous Selection Process 2025 - Prelims

- The Preliminary Exam will comprise a single paper with 100 multiple-choice objective questions.
- These questions will be divided into General Studies (150 marks) and Arithmetic (50 marks), with each question carrying 2 marks.
- The exam will have a total score of 200 marks and a duration of 1 hour and 30 minutes.
- It is important to note that the Preliminary Exam serves as a screening test to shortlist candidates for the Mains Examination. However, the marks obtained in this stage will not be considered while preparing the final merit list.

WBPSM Miscellaneous Selection Process 2025 - Final

- The Main examination is comprised of three papers and includes conventional type questions.
- Paper I is dedicated to English, Paper II covers Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali/Santali, and Paper III incorporates General Studies and Arithmetic.
- Both Papers I and II have a total of 150 marks each, with a duration of 1 hour and 30 minutes for each paper.
- Paper III is further divided into General Studies (Group A) with 100 marks and Arithmetic (Group B) with 50 marks, amounting to a total of 150 marks. The time allocated for Paper III is 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Responses for Group A (General Studies) can be provided in English, Bengali, or Nepali, while answers for Group B (Arithmetic) can be given in English or Bengali.
- Notably, all three papers (Papers I, II & III) will be conducted on the same day.

WBPSM Miscellaneous Selection Process 2025 - Personality Test

- The Personality Test carries a total of 100 marks.
- Candidates will be shortlisted for the Personality Test based on their merit in the Final Examination (Written).
- The Final Merit List is prepared by combining the scores from all three papers of the Final Examination and the Personality Test.
