To apply for the position of Constable, you must be an Indian citizen. Additionally, your age should be between 18 and 30 years as of 01/01/2024. Furthermore, you need to have passed the Madhyamik Examination from the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or an equivalent qualification.

Similarly, to apply for the SI position, you must be a citizen of India. Your age should be between 20 (twenty) and 30 (thirty) years as of 01.01.2024. Additionally, you must possess a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent.


West Bengal Police Recruitment 2024 - Vacancy

West Bengal Police Recruitment 2024 - Exam Pattern

Understanding the pattern allows you to manage your time during the exam more efficiently. You can allocate time according to the number of questions and the complexity of each section. Thus, below we have discussed the exam pattern for West Bengal Police Recruitment.

The recruitment process for Constable positions in the West Bengal Police involves several stages: a Written Examination, followed by a Physical Measurement Test (PMT), a Physical Efficiency Test (PET), and an Interview. Details of the Written Examination:

- The exam will consist of 85 objective type questions with multiple-choice answers, each question carrying 1 mark.
- For each incorrect answer, there will be a negative marking of ¼th of the total marks allotted to the question.
- The exam will be OMR-based and follow a multiple-choice question (MCQ) format.
- The duration of the written exam will be one hour.

Understanding the structure of the WBP SI exam is like having a clear roadmap for your upcoming journey. Allow us to simplify the WBP SI exam pattern for you. For the recruitment of Sub-Inspector (UB) and Sub-Inspector (AB) positions in West Bengal Police, you'll need to navigate through several stages. Firstly, you must clear the Preliminary Examination, which acts as a screening test. If successful, you'll proceed to the Physical Measurement Test (PMT) and Physical Efficiency Test (PET), followed by the Final Combined Competitive Examination and a Personality Test.

- The Preliminary Examination is a 90-minute test worth 200 marks. Its purpose is to qualify candidates for the PMT and PET.
- The Final Combined Competitive Examination consists of three papers with conventional-type questions, totaling 200 marks.





West Bengal Police Recruitment 2024 - Syllabus

Now that you have a solid understanding of the West Bengal Police Recruitment exam format, it is critical to delve into the syllabus. By knowing the syllabus, you can set clear goals and milestones for your study. You can break down the syllabus into manageable parts and create a study plan accordingly.

The syllabus for WB Police Constable is as follows:

- General Awareness and Knowledge 25 marks
- English 10 marks
- Elementary Mathematics (Madhyamik standard) 25 marks
- · Reasoning and Logical Analysis 25 marks

Moreover, if you intend to apply for the **WB Police SI** position, the syllabus is outlined as follows:

Preliminary Exam:

- General Studies
- · Logical & Analytical Reasoning
- Arithmetic

Final Combined Competitive Examination:

- Paper I: The Paper I of Final Combined Competitive Examination includes the General Studies and Arithmetic paper which is worth 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, along with 25 marks each for Logical & Analytical Reasoning and Arithmetic). The exam duration is 2 hours.
- Paper II: The Paper II of Final Combined Competitive Examination for Sub-Inspectors in West Bengal Police includes an English paper worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.
- Paper III: It includes a paper on Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.

West Bengal Police Recruitment 2024 - How to Apply

The application period for the WB Police Constable ran from March 7 to April 5, 2024, while the application period for the SI position was from March 9 to April 7, 2024. Candidates had about a month to apply for each position.
