Citizenship

Language

You must be proficient in speaking, reading, and writing Bengali to be eligible for the West Bengal Police SI 2024 exam. However, this requirement does not apply to individuals who are permanent residents of the hill sub-divisions of Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts. For applicants from these hill subdivisions, the provisions of the West Bengal Official Language Act, 1961, will be applicable.



Educational Qualification

To be eligible for the West Bengal Police SI 2024 exam, you must hold a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent.

Physical Efficiency Test (PET):



Your performance in the Physical Efficiency Test will be evaluated based on various criteria, including the 400-meter run or the 800-meter run. The specific details can be found in the excerpt below from the official notification:

F. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) :-

Sl. No.	Class of Candidate	Minimum Efficiency
1.	Male candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	800 metres run within 3 minutes.
2.	Female candidates (Unarmed Branch)	400 metres run within 2 minutes.
3.	Transgender Candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	400 metres run within 1 minute 40 seconds.

Final Combined Competitive Examination:

The Final Combined Competitive Examination consists of three papers with conventional-type questions:

- **Paper I:** General Studies and Arithmetic, totaling 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, 25 marks for Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and 25 marks for Arithmetic), with a duration of 2 hours.
- **Paper II:** English, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.
- **Paper III:** Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.

Personality Test:

Candidates who meet all the eligibility criteria and perform well in the Final Combined Competitive Examination will be selected based on merit for the Personality Test. A minimum passing score of 8 marks is required for the Personality Test.
