West Bengal Police Sub Inspector 2024 - Eligibility Criteria

Citizenship

Age Limit

As of January 1, 2024, applicants for the West Bengal Police Sub Inspector 2024 exam must be at least 20 years old, with a maximum age limit of 30 years. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates, by 3 years for Other Backward Classes-A and Other Backward Classes-B candidates, and by 3 years for transgender persons.

Language

To be eligible for West Bengal Police Sub Inspector 2024, you must be proficient in speaking, reading, and writing Bengali. However, this requirement does not apply to individuals who are permanent residents of the hill sub-divisions of Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts. For applicants from these hill subdivisions, the provisions of the West Bengal Official Language Act, 1961, will be applicable.

Educational Qualification

To be eligible for the West Bengal Police Sub Inspector 2024 exam, you must have a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent.

West Bengal Police Sub Inspector 2024 - Exam Pattern

Understanding the structure of the WBP SI exam is like having a clear roadmap for your journey. The West Bengal Police Sub Inspector examination consists of four stages:

1. Preliminary Examination - 200 marks
2. Physical Measurement Test (PMT) & Physical Efficiency Test (PET)
3. Final Combined Competitive Examination - 200 marks
4. Personality Test - 30 marks

Let's examine the exam pattern for each of these stages:

Preliminary Examination:

- The exam includes sections on General Studies, Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and Arithmetic, totaling 200 marks.
- The General Studies section is worth 100 marks and comprises 50 questions.
- The Logical & Analytical Reasoning section is worth 50 marks and includes 25 questions.
- The Arithmetic section is also worth 50 marks and contains 25 questions.
- The exam duration is 90 minutes.

Physical Measurement Test (PMT):

In the PMT, you will be assessed based on physical criteria established by the West Bengal Police. The specific criteria can be found in the official notification snippet below:

Physical Efficiency Test (PET):



In the Physical Efficiency Test, your performance will be assessed based on various criteria such as the 400-meter run or the 800-meter run. The specific details are provided in the excerpt below from the official notification:

F. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) :-

Sl. No.	Class of Candidate	Minimum Efficiency
1.	Male candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	800 metres run within 3 minutes.
2.	Female candidates (Unarmed Branch)	400 metres run within 2 minutes.
3.	Transgender Candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	400 metres run within 1 minute 40 seconds.

Final Combined Competitive Examination:

The Final Combined Competitive Examination will consist of three papers with conventional-type questions:

- **Paper I:** General Studies and Arithmetic, totaling 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, 25 marks for Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and 25 marks for Arithmetic), with a duration of 2 hours.
- **Paper II:** English, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.
- **Paper III:** Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.

Personality Test:

A select group of candidates who meet all the eligibility criteria will be chosen based on merit from the results of the Final Combined Competitive Examination. These candidates will be invited to participate in the Personality Test, for which a minimum passing score of 8 marks is required.

- **Arithmetic:** Questions will be based on the syllabus of the Madhyamik Examination of the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education.

Paper II of the Final Combined Competitive Examination - English:

- Creating a report based on provided points or materials.
- Translating from Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali to English, as required.
- Summarizing or condensing a prose passage.
- Ensuring correct word usage, sentence correction, familiarity with common phrases, and understanding of synonyms and antonyms.

Paper III of the Final Combined Competitive Examination - Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali:

- Creating a report based on provided points or materials.
- Translating from English to Bengali or English to Nepali for candidates who have chosen 'Bengali' or 'Nepali,' respectively, and translating from Hindi/Urdu to Bengali for candidates who have selected Hindi or Urdu.
